Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (the “Company”) submitted revised tariff pages on June 30, 2023 to revert distribution rates to a 12-month schedule consistent with Order No. 26,709 issued in Docket DE 22-030 on October 20, 2022 (the “Order”). The Company’s revised tariff pages included page 65-F which relates to the Company Rate EV-2 because the distribution rate is a component of Rate EV-2. Subsequent to the Company’s June 30, 2023 filing, the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission’s (the “Commission”) Order *Nisi* Approving Rate EV-2 Tariff Page Correction, Order No. 26,847, became effective on July 14, 2023.

Accordingly, the Company now submits a further revised version of tariff page 65-F that reflects the updated distribution rates for effect August 1, 2023 and the corrected charges applicable to Rate EV-2 customers as approved in Order No. 26,847.<sup>1</sup> The discrepancy noted in the August 1, 2023 letter from the Commission’s Tariff Administrator is the result of filing the updated tariff pages in this proceeding prior to the order effective date for Order No. 26,847 in Docket DE 23-053.
