Revised Proposed Rate Case Expense Recoupment Surcharge

Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to the Commission's temporary electronic filing requirements, and pursuant to Order No. 26,862 dated July 27, 2023, Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. (PWW) filed its rate case expenses on August 28, 2023. Since that filing, the Department of Energy has conducted discovery and as a result of that discovery, certain corrections were made to the rate case expense documentation.

First, on Bates page 5, the entry for Rath, Young & Pignatelli for \$840.00 has been removed because the expense can be argued to be unrelated to the rate case. This removal is reflected in the new summary page at Bates page 1. Second, page two of the invoice at Bates page 27 was missing. Therefore, page two was added as Bates page 28 and the last page of the rate case documentation is now Bates page 29. Third and last, the invoice date on the bottom of Bates page 3 was incorrect. The date 10/12/21 was corrected to 5/3/22.

These revisions represent the extent of changes from the initially-filed expenses. In light of the reduction of expenses by \$840.00, Pennichuck Water Works, Inc. now requests recovery of a slightly lower amount in rate case expenses of \$36,656.34.
