On October 31, 2022, the Commission issued Order No. 26,715 in Docket No. DG 22-045 approving rates for the Winter 2022–2023 and Summer 2023 Cost of Gas and annual LDAC. Included with this letter are the following tariff pages reflecting the approved rates set forth in the above-referenced order.

- First Revised Page 5
- Second Revised Page 91, 94, 96, 98, 99, 100, 153, and 154
- Fourth Revised Page 92
- Seventh Revised Page 95 and 101
- Fifteenth Revised Page 87 and 89
- Twenty-seventh Revised Page 4
- Twenty-ninth Revised Page 3
- Thirty-first Revised Page 1

After reviewing the order and the tariff pages, two differences were discovered that required correction.

- The proposed LDAC rates of \$0.1110-residential and \$0.0888-C&I included January 1, 2023, Energy Efficiency Charges of \$0.0664-residential and \$0.0442-C&I. Per Order No. 26,306, the current rates of \$0.0640-residential and \$0.0426-C&I should have been used effective November 1, 2022. The corrected LDAC rates in the compliance tariff pages are \$0.1086residential and \$0.0872-C&I.
- The C&I-LLF (High winter use) and C&I-HLF (Low winter use) rates in Order No. 26,715 page 11 are reversed for both Winter 2022–2023 and Summer 2023. These are correctly stated in the compliance tariff pages.
