Good afternoon Steve,

I have fully reviewed the supporting documentation related to Bedford Waste's Step 2 expenses as submitted by you on April 26, 2024. The DOE will not be submitting Data Requests. As a result, would the Company be amenable to removing the hour estimated to review the DOE DRs and Draft response (see St. Cyr invoice 05/01)? This would represent a deduction of \$141.75 or \$1.82 per customer. The Company would not be required to refile documents. The DOE would discuss the adjustment in its letter to the PUC.

$\$3,254.89 - 141.75 = \$3,113.14 / 78 = \$39.91$ , a reduction of \$1.82 per customer.
