RE: Docket No. DE 22-060 Consideration of Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure, Including Compensation of Customer-Generators Stakeholder Report

Chair Goldner:

The parties to this docket have now had three 3 to 4-hour stakeholder discussions covering a range of net metering-related issues and considered a variety of party positions on those issues. All the mandatory utility-parties were in attendance for all stakeholder sessions. The New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE) made available their consultant, Dunsky, who authored the VDER study report that was filed in this docket on October 31, 2022. Dunsky provided a presentation with limited updates to the original report and a follow-up presentation in response to additional stakeholder questions. The DOE plans to file an addendum to the VDER study report with study updates by the end of May.

Although the parties did not necessarily reach consensus on specific issues related to net metering, the sessions were frank and productive, and all parties were afforded an opportunity to speak on any and all issues raised. At the conclusion of the final session, it was asked if an additional session was needed or desired by any party, to which no one replied in the affirmative. At this time there are no further stakeholder sessions scheduled, and the parties are ready to proceed to the procedural phase of the docket. However, if issues arise with any party prior to the next date on the procedural schedule that warrant further discussion no one is opposed to holding an additional session to address any issues relevant to the docket.
