Request to modify procedural schedule

Chairman Goldner:

Due to the quantity of discovery served on the utilities on August 24, 2023, Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy; Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty; and Until Energy Systems, Inc. conferred with the parties who served discovery: New Hampshire Department of Energy; the Office of the Consumer Advocate; Clean Energy New Hampshire; and the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire (altogether the “Requesting Parties”) to see if modifications to the procedural schedule would be acceptable. Those parties agreed on the modified schedule below. Granite State Hydropower Association; Walmart Inc.; IBEW Local 490; Colonial Power Group, Inc. also support the schedule as proposed below. Standard Power of America; Consumer Energy Alliance; and Conservation Law Foundation were also notified of the proposed modified procedural schedule, and at this time, no objections have been made. The parties listed at the outset of this letter tried to maintain as much fidelity to the original schedule as possible. The full procedural schedule is below and the modifications appear in bold:


