By this letter, Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty; Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy; Unitil Energy Systems, Inc.; the Offica of the Consumer Advocate; Conservation Law Foundation; Clean Energy New Hampshire; Granite State Hyrdopower Association; and Standard Power of America (the "Parties") hereby respectfully notify the Commission that a settlement agreement has not yet been finalized in this docket. The Parties appreciate that the Commission was responding to a party request at the status conference that the Commission provide a deadline for any settlement agreement to be filed. But with the hearings likely to be scheduled in late August, and issuance of the Commission's record requests in this docket, which are currently the subject of two motions for rehearing filed by certain of the Parties, the Parties put the development of the settlement agreement on hold pending the outcome of these recent developments. The Parties would respectfully request to file any settlement agreement in this docket consistent with the parameters of Puc 203.20.
