Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy – withdrawal of regulatory asset petition


Chairman Goldner:

On June 14, 2023 Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (“Eversource”), in conjunction with the other New Hampshire regulated electric utilities, filed a petition seeking, among other things, a temporary waiver from Puc 2205.16(d)(1) (which directs the utilities to provide bill-ready billing) while the work to implement bill-ready billing functionality is completed. The Commission opened Docket No. DE 23-063 to consider that petition and its requests for relief. Among those requests is a cost recovery proposal for the utilities to recover all incremental costs stemming directly from implementing and complying with the Puc 2200 rules.

The cost recovery proposal within the petition’s supporting testimony in Docket No. DE 23-063 provides for comprehensive cost recovery treatment for all the New Hampshire electric utilities to implement the Puc 2200 rules, which makes this docket duplicative, and it also applies only to Eversource. Eversource therefore respectfully withdraws its petition for a regulatory asset and asks that the Commission close Docket No. DE 22-072, as this will resolve all pending matters before the Commission in this docket. Eversource thanks the Commission and the parties to this docket for their time and efforts and looks forward to continuing the discussion of these relevant issues regarding cost recovery in the more inclusive context of Docket No. DE 23-063.
