LIMITED MOTION TO INTERVENE TO RESPOND TO “OBJECTION TO RESIDENTS OF COLONIAL DRIVE PARTIALLY ASSENTED TO MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDING PENDING EXPLORATION OF ASSET TRANSFER”

NOW COMES the State of New Hampshire, Dept. of Environmental Services (“NHDES”) and requests that this Commission grant its Limited Motion to Intervene.

1. For the second time in five weeks, the new intervenor, Lamprey Suburban Septic, Inc. (“Lamprey”) asks the Commission to require that the N.H. Dept. of Environmental Services (“NHDES”) be joined as a party.

2. NHDES now files this limited motion to intervene in order to respond to Lamprey’s request.

3. This intervention is limited to, and is solely for the purpose of responding to Lamprey’s “Objection to Residents of Colonial Drive Partially Assented To Motion to Stay Proceeding Pending Exploration of Asset Transfer”

4. The parties have been contacted and have assented to NHDES’ limited intervention.

Wherefore, NHDES respectfully requests that the Commission:

A. Grant NHDES’ motion for limited intervention; and,

B. In the event such limited intervention is granted, accept and consider the objection attached hereto.
