**RE:** Puc 2204.04 Notification of Commencement of Service | Dover + Cheshire Co.

Pursuant to Puc 2204.04 I am writing to provide official Notification of Community Power Aggregation Commencement of Service not sooner than 45 days hence, or on or after October 26, 2023 for the City of Dover and for Cheshire County for which the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire serves as agent for purposes of implementing and operating their CPA programs. The three utilities noticed in this email serve some portion of some of these communities.

The City of Dover will be launching primarily on an opt-out alternative default service provider basis. Cheshire County will be launching primarily on an opt-out alternative default service provider basis for municipalities within the county that have requested to participate by a majority vote of their respective governing bodies, which at present includes the Towns of Dublin, Fitzwilliam, and Nelson. Some groups of customers in both CPAs may be offered service only on an opt-in basis, particularly those that cannot be properly served by CPAs until certain data sharing and Puc 2200 rule compliance issues are resolved, including net energy metered customers.
