Dear Chairman Goldner:

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp., d/b/a Liberty, I write to provide a further update regarding settlement discussions in the above docket.

All parties continue to meet and are currently working through the final details of a comprehensive settlement agreement. However, the discussions have been time consuming, and the parties will be unable to file a signed agreement by our previously stated target date of October 11.

In light of the Commission's October 9, 2024, procedural order that set November 15 as the date for filing testimony in support of a settlement agreement, December 12 as the deadline for any rebuttal testimony, and hearings in January, the parties will endeavor to file a settlement agreement sufficiently in advance of the November 15 date and thus the parties respectfully ask the Commission to retain the filing deadlines and hearing dates in its October 9 procedural order.

Note that all parties have reviewed this letter and support its request.
