Dear Chair Goldner:

On behalf of Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (“Unitil” or the “Company”) I enclose the Company’s compliance filing pursuant to the Commission’s directive in Order No. 26,850 (June 16, 2023) as modified by the Commission’s Procedural Order Re: Motion for Waiver and Modification dated August 28, 2023. In Order No. 26,850, the Commission directed Unitil to “file, by the 10th day of the following month [during the upcoming default service period], a summary comparison of the monthly average ISO-New England market electricity prices with the power supply charge components for UES’s Small and Medium customer groups.” Order No. 26,850 at 10. The Commission subsequently granted the Company’s request that this requirement be modified to be due on the 30<sup>th</sup> day following each reporting month. The 30<sup>th</sup> day of September fell on a Saturday.
