I have just finished reading our consumer advocate's well considered position on Docket No. DE 23-068 in regard to HB 549.

In particular I took note of the risk in walking back our NH Saves program. It is easily recognized that the least expensive kilowatt is the one you don't have to produce. NH Saves has proven and direct results in lowering demand, which is still the best means of controlling cost.
