Thank you for your work on this Commission.
Please pass the 2024-2026 Triennial Energy Efficiency Plan.

This plan costs very little to ratepayers and provides huge returns.
Energy efficiency is the most cost effective path to keep energy costs as low as possible for all energy users.

Also, this plan builds jobs that are being lost to neighboring states that support more energy efficiency programs.

The cut backs and uncertainty in the NH previous plan meant that businesses that install energy efficient products such as Heat Pumps and insulation are moving to neighboring states.
