Eversource's position that approval of the 2024-2026 Triennial Plan what constituted approval of the lost base revenue as described in Marisa Paruta's attachment K, that this would be a separate rate charge to Eversource taxpayers. The LDR could be filed sooner but would need to reply on forecasted rates. The Commission will take it under advisement.

Unitil Energy Systems, Inc and Conservation Law Foundation requested one week to respond in writing to OCA's Request to Incorporate IR 22-042 Motion for Disqualification of Commissioners to this Docket. All other parties had no position. The matter will be taken under advisement and an order will be issued.

Eversource would like to see a Liberty presentation so they can ask questions vs. written and whether the conversation should be on the record , they think probably a more candid exchange if it weren't on the record. That is their recommendation. Commission will take under advisement.
