## Unitil - Order Nisi Approving Requests to Modify Energy Efficiency Portion of System Benefits Charges and Local Distribution Adjustment Charges (DE 23-098)

New Hampshire

Gas, Electric, Dual Gas & Electric

In this order nisi, the Commission approves tariff change filings reflecting a 4.896 percent increase to the energy efficiency charge (EEC) charged to New Hampshire ratepayers and collected by the electric and natural gas utilities. The average residential electric ratepayer, using 625 kilowatt-hours (kWh) per month, will experience an annual increase of approximately \$2.02 in 2024 over the current annual EEC bill of roughly \$41.26. The average residential natural gas ratepayer of Northern Utilities, Inc. and Liberty Utilities (EnergyNorth Natural Gas) Corp. d/b/a Liberty, using 795 therms annually over the summer and winter seasons, will experience an annual bill increase of approximately \$2.02 and \$2.60 in 2024 relative to existing total annual EEC bills of roughly \$41.31 and \$53.03, respectively. The General Court mandated this increase to the EEC. RSA 374-F:3, VI-a(d)(2), as amended. Under the law, the increase is calculated by the New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE).
