Pursuant to the Commission's Commencement of Adjudicative Proceeding and Notice of Prehearing Conference, dated February 16, 2024 (the "Order"), specifically the second ordering clause on page 5 thereof, attached please find a proposed procedural schedule which includes the cancelation of the prehearing conference and technical session currently scheduled for March 27. The proposed procedural schedule includes a range of dates containing the parties' availability for a final hearing during the week of July 22. The Joint Petitioners do not believe a final hearing would consume more than two days, and it is possible that a final hearing may be concluded in a single day.
