Dear Mr. Goldner:

Enclosed for filing with the Commission, please find an original copy of the Mill Brook Village Water System's proposed revision to page 6 of the Tarrif. This is in keeping with section E of the approved Stipulation Agreement which states: E. Adjustment to Rate Without Rate Proceeding The Settling Parties acknowledge that, while the Millbrook Village water system has been constructed to provide water service to 64 end-users, there are currently 37 customers 2 DW 14-176 Millbrook Village Water System Stipulation Agreement taking service. Since no real estate has been sold in Millbrook Village's proposed franchise area since 2008, the Settling Parties agree and recommend a water rate based on the 3.7 current customers. However, the Settling Parties agree and recommend that, in the event any new customers connect to the system and begin taking service, Millbrook Village agrees to file a revised tariff rate page within 15 days of any customer being connected. A new water service rate shall be calculated and filed using the revenue requirement recommended in this Settlement Agreement, \$23,568, divided by the new number of customers, and then divided by four for the new quarterly rate. This new rate is to be effective for service rendered on and after the first day of the quarter within which one or more new customers are connected. The Settling Parties agree and recommend that the revenue requirement in this stipulation will not change as a result of this provision, and that Millbrook Village is not entitled to seek recovery of any additional costs it may have occurred since the January 1, 2015 effective date of rate recommended herein. For clarification, the Settling parties intend that the customer rate under this provision will change in the future solely based on the number of customers taking service. Nothing in this provision precludes Millbrook Village from filing a full rate proceeding at any time, consistent with applicable law and regulations of the Commission.

All customers were be notified of the new reduced rates with a note that was included with their 1st quarter 2024 invoice on March 31, 2024 (mailed on March 15, 2024). Customers were emailed as well on March 21, 2024.
