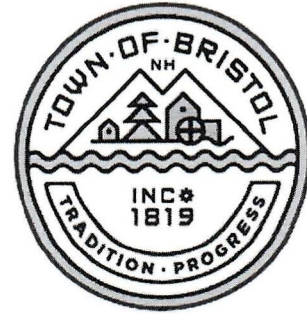
**Subject:** DE 24-072 - Puc 2204.01 – Bristol Community Power - Submission of an amended Electric Aggregation Plan Per Commission Denial Order NO. 27,028.

Dear Chairman Goldner,

On behalf of the Town of Bristol, please find attached the Bristol Community Power Electric Aggregation Plan, as amended, for review and approval by the Commission pursuant to RSA 53-E:7, II and Puc 2204.01.

1. This is an amended final plan that was approved by the Bristol Select Board on July 18th, 2024
2. The amended plan names the New Hampshire Electric Cooperative (NHEC) as an electric distribution utility for the town and clarifies that NHEC members will only be enrolled in Bristol Community Power on an “opt-in” basis.
