Technical Statement of Adam R.M. Yusuf

A. Purpose of Technical Statement

Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. (“Liberty” or “the Company”) submits this technical statement in support of the Company’s request that the Commission approve a revised tariff page to fix a typographical error, pursuant to the “service or tariff change” provisions of Puc 1605. The page in question does not reflect the proper threshold for customers to be considered for a change to the G-3 rate class.

Specifically, the Company proposes to change the number “180” kW to “18” kW in the first paragraph of Thirteenth Revised Page 98 of the Company’s NHPUC No. 21 Tariff, which currently reads as follows.

“A customer may be transferred from rate G-2 at its request or at the option of the Company if the customer’s twelve (12) month average monthly demand is less than 180 kW of demand for three consecutive months”.

Considering that the lower end of the demand range for G-2 is 20 kW, the above text should state that the “...average monthly demand is less than 18 kW of demand for three consecutive months.”

This correction does not impact the Company’s earnings and does not impact customers or their bills as it is merely fixing a typographical error. See Puc 1605.01(b).
