Motion to Admit an Additional Exhibit

To the Parties:

On October 26, 2018, Staff filed a Motion to Reopen Record to Admit an Additional Exhibit. Specifically, Staff seeks to admit a list of eight customer education activities, seven of which Liberty agreed to undertake as part of its decoupling education plan. Staff asked that the list be admitted as Exhibit 93. Staff stated that Liberty's witnesses summarized the list at the hearing held on October 22, 2018, but Staff believes the admission of the list would aid the Commission in deciding whether or not to approve Liberty's decoupling education plan.

On October 26, Liberty stated that it did not object to this Motion.

The Commission has reviewed the record and the probative value of proposed Exhibit 93. In accordance with Puc 203.30(c)(1), the Commission has found that the exhibit provides more detail about the activities than was provided in the oral testimony, and that its admission will assist the Commission in deciding whether to approve Liberty's decoupling education plan. Because Liberty did not object to Staff's motion, the Commission found that no further process is necessary to protect Liberty's right of cross examination pursuant to RSA 541-A:33, IV. See Puc 203.30(c)(2). The Commission therefore granted Staff's motion to reopen the record, admitted Exhibit 93 into evidence, and then closed the record.
