To the Parties:


On January 14, 2019, the Commission held a duly-noticed prehearing conference in the above-referenced matter. Appearances were entered by Dixville Telephone Company (DTC), New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (AT&T Mobility), and by Commission Staff. The Commission granted the petition to intervene filed by AT&T Mobility.
