## Re: DM 18-172, Agera Energy, LLC Request to Withdraw Registration as a Competitive Electric Power Supplier

Dear Mr. Calabrese,

On June 5, 2020, Agera Energy, LLC (Agera) filed a letter seeking to withdraw its registration as a competitive electric power supplier (CEPS). In the letter, Agera noted that, pursuant to an order issued by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court in the Southern District of New York, Agera had either transferred all of its New Hampshire electric supply customers to Constellation New Energy, Inc. or returned them to utility default service. As of February 27, 2020, Agera ceased to serve customers in New Hampshire, according to the letter.

Commission Staff filed a memorandum on July 9, 2020, in which it confirmed its review of the withdrawal request and recommended that Agera's CEPS registration be withdrawn and terminated, pursuant to N.H. Admin. R., Puc 2003.08. Staff stated that the Commission's Consumer Services Division is aware of no pending customer complaints regarding Agera.

Accordingly, Agera's CEPS registration is deemed withdrawn and terminated, effective as of the date of this letter.
