
the largest in the U.S. based on the number of customer records compromised.

TJX says about three-quarters of the 45.7 million cards had either expired by the time of the theft, or the stolen information didn't include security code data from the cards' magnetic stripes. However, TJX also has said the intruders could have tapped the unencrypted flow of information to card issuers as customers checked out with their credit cards.

The company and the U.S. Secret Service are investigating. The only arrests so far have come in Florida, where 10 people who aren't believed to be the TJX hackers are accused of using stolen TJX-customer data to buy Wal-Mart gift cards.

On January 31, 2007, Verizon and FairPoint filed a petition with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for approval of the transfer of Verizon's wireline local and long distance businesses in New Hampshire to FairPoint.

FairPoint is headquartered in Charlotte, North Carolina. Through certain subsidiaries it currently provides local service in East Conway and Chatham, New Hampshire, as well as in portions of Maine and Vermont.

According to the petition, the proposed transfer of assets would result in FairPoint acquiring the Verizon franchise to provide wireline telecommunication services in New Hampshire, and owning the network Verizon currently uses to provide those services.

The Commission will hold a series of evening hearings during the month of May for the purposes of taking public comment on the proposed transaction. All hearings will begin at 7:00 p.m. The first such hearing will be held on May 2, 2007 at Merrimack High School.

The Town of Merrimack ordains that in accordance with the Charter Article V, Section 5-5 Emergency Ordinances, an emergency exists as a result of the heavy rains and flooding of April 15 to April 18, 2007.

In recognition of the threat to life, public health and safety, the Council hereby authorizes the Town Manager to waive or modify Town policies, procedures or ordinances to facilitate repair and recovery from the damage caused by flooding and other natural phenomena associated with the storm.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and automatically expire in 61 days (on or about June 18, 2007) as provided by Charter Article V, Section 5-5, D.
