Testimony of Susan M. Baldwin and David Brevitz on behalf of the OCA

Dear Ms. Howland:

I enclose for filing an original and seven copies of two of the five versions of the prefiled direct testimony of Susan M. Baldwin and two of the four versions of the prefiled direct testimony of David Brevitz on behalf of the Office of Consumer Advocate. Specifically, I enclose the "Highly Confidential Level 1" and "Public" versions of both Ms. Baldwin's and Mr. Brevitz's testimony.

The multiple versions were necessitated by the four different levels of redaction created by FairPoint and Verizon (the "Joint Petitioners"). In addition to a "Public" version, there are four separate confidential levels: "Highly Confidential Level 1"; "Highly Confidential Level 2"; "Highly Confidential Level 3"; and "Confidential." The four confidential versions of testimony are distinguished by who may receive them, according to the Joint Petitioners, as explained below.

"Highly Confidential Level 1" testimony and exhibits ("HCL1") are fully unredacted and contain the highest level of confidential information. "Highly Confidential Level 1" testimony and exhibits are being provided only to the Commission, Staff and its consultants, and the Joint Petitioners. Those receiving the "Highly Confidential Level 1" version of testimony and exhibits will also receive copies of the "Public" or fully redacted version of the OCA's testimony, and any "Highly Confidential Level 2," "Highly Confidential Level 3," "Confidential" and "Public" exhibits.

"Highly Confidential Level 2" testimony and exhibits ("HCL2") is the next highest level of confidentiality. The "Highly Confidential Level 2" versions of testimony and exhibits are being

provided only to the attorneys for the Labor intervenors and Randall Barber, a consultant to the Labor intervenors. Those receiving the "Highly Confidential Level 2" version of testimony and exhibits will also receive copies of the "Public" version of the OCA's testimony and any "Highly Confidential Level 3," "Confidential" and "Public" exhibits.

"Highly Confidential Level 3" and exhibits ("HCL3") are the lowest level of "Highly Confidential" (but more confidential than the "Confidential" version). The "Highly Confidential Level 3" version of testimony and exhibits are being provided only to the attorneys for the electric utilities and New Hampshire Telephone Association. Those receiving the "Highly Confidential Level 3" version of testimony and exhibits will also receive copies of the "Public" testimony and the "Confidential" and "Public" exhibits.

The "Confidential" versions of testimony and exhibits correspond to the lowest level of confidentiality. The "Confidential" version of testimony and exhibits are being disclosed to all individuals who have signed a protective agreement with the Joint Petitioners. Those receiving the "Confidential" version of testimony and exhibits will also receive copies of the "Public" testimony and exhibits.

The "Public" version of testimony and exhibits is being provided via electronic mail to all individuals on the Commission's service list, including those mentioned above who will receive a confidential version of the OCA's testimony and one or more versions of confidential exhibits. As mentioned above, the OCA is also filing paper copies of the "Public" version with the Commission.
