**MOTION OF DSCI CORPORATION
TO WITHDRAW ITS PETITION TO INTERVENE**


DSCI Corporation ("DSCI") hereby withdraws its Petition to Intervene in this proceeding. DSCI's Petition to Intervene was granted by the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") on March 16, 2007. FairPoint Communications, Inc. ("FairPoint") and the Verizon parties have cooperated with DSCI to address its concerns, and FairPoint and DSCI have entered into an agreement that resolves all outstanding issues. DSCI is satisfied that FairPoint will continue to provide it with wholesale services in New Hampshire after the merger transaction on terms at least as favorable as the terms on which Verizon has been providing wholesale services before the merger transaction. As a result, DSCI supports approval of this merger transaction by the Commission, and believes that its participation in this proceeding is no longer necessary. DSCI therefore respectfully requests that this Motion to Withdraw be granted. DSCI also no longer will support its joint pre-filed testimony filed with DIECA Communications, Inc. d/b/a Covad.

Upon approval of this Motion, please note that the undersigned counsel will no longer be appearing in this docket for DSCI and will, instead, only be serving as counsel to Covad. Please also remove Sean Dandley of DSCI from the hard copy and email service lists.
