- a. Does Verizon NH intend to take any steps between now and closing to increase the number of access lines that are broadband qualified? If yes, please describe. If no, why not?
- b. Please identify the five most recent wire centers in which Verizon NH has deployed broadband, the dates of such deployment, the individuals and positions of those responsible for determining that such deployment should occur, and the criteria used for deciding to undertake such deployment.
- c. Please identify the individual(s) and positions of the Verizon NH employees in charge of determining when and where to deploy broadband.

## SUPPLEMENTAL REPLY:

- (b) and (c). Objection. The request for the identity of the individuals by name and job description at Verizon seeks information the disclosure of which would result in an invasion of privacy of Verizon employees to the extent names are sought. Subject to and without waiving the objection, Verizon responds as follows:
- a. Verizon fully supports broadband service where it is presently deployed. Broadband investment decisions are based on network opportunities/capabilities, the costs associated with the prospective investments, and revenue projections.
- b. The five most recent wire centers in which Verizon NH has deployed (expanded) broadband are:

Those responsible for determining that deployment should occur are discussed in Verizon NH's reply to OCA R-14(c) and OCA GII 1-55.

The criteria used for deciding to undertake deployment is discussed in Verizon NH's replies to OCA GII 1-53, OCA GII 1-54, and OCA GII 1-59.

c. Determining when and where to deploy broadband in New Hampshire is a collaborative effort involving various managers within Business Development, Finance, Marketing, Network Engineering, Network Operations, Network Planning and Program Management.
