Dear Chairwoman Martin:

On July 30, 2021, the Commission issued Order No. 26,505 which denied the Company's request to implement the step increase as of August 1, 2021, as provided for in the Settlement Agreement. The Order directed the Company,

not to collect any revenue requirement associated the first step adjustment until it files a related request with the Commission containing the same level of detail as specified in the Settlement Agreement for the second step increase and specifically identifying which projects shall be considered for prudence determinations up to but not in excess of the \$4 million dollar cap, the Commission holds a hearing, and the Commission has found the 2020 plant additions necessary to support the revenue requirement cap to be prudently incurred, used, and useful. Upon receipt of the request, the Commission will schedule such a hearing. We direct the Company to request an effective date for the step increase no sooner than 30 days from the date the request is filed.
