#### **2022 Default Service Solicitations**

### **Motion for Remote Participation**

Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp., d/b/a Liberty, through counsel, respectfully moves the Commission pursuant to Puc 203.07 to allow for remote participation of Aaron Doll, Liberty's Senior Director, Energy and Strategy, who cannot appear in person at the January 11, 2023, hearing in this docket.

In support of this motion Unitil states the following:

- 1. Today the Commission scheduled a January 11, 2023, hearing to consider the results of Liberty's second default service solicitation for the large customer block for the period February 1, 2023, through April 30, 2023.
- 2. As will be reflected the filing Liberty will make on January 6, there were no bids to serve that block. Therefore, as discussed during the December 20, 2022, hearing in this docket, Liberty will self-supply those customers for that period.
- 3. Also as discussed during the December 20, hearing, it is Mr. Doll's group that will be primarily responsible for procuring the energy for these customers. The January 6 filing will include testimony sponsored by Mr. Doll and the New Hampshire-based Liberty team.
- 4. Mr. Doll is based in Joplin, Missouri.
- 5. To allow for Mr. Doll's participation, and to avoid the expense of having him travel to New Hampshire, Liberty files this motion to request that he be allowed to participate remotely.
- 6. The Commission has previously granted similar requests to allow for Mr. Doll's remote appearance in this docket, both at the December 20 hearing and the November 14 prehearing conference. Liberty respectfully asks the Commission to grant this third request for the same reasons.

WHEREFORE, Liberty respectfully requests that the Commission:

- (1) Allow Mr. Doll to participate remotely in the January 11, 2023, hearing; and
- (2) Order such further relief as may be just and equitable.
