This is a follow-up to my letter in January In support of maintaining the current tariff system for net metering. I've continued to follow the docket and have been encouraged to see the major parties reaching a proposed settlement which offers some continuity while allowing for time-of-use rates in the future. Bedford's municipal project is an example of one that has a long development cycle with sunk connection preparation costs. Solar projects of this magnitude as well as home rooftop solar will help cushion the increased needs arising from electrification of heating and transportation at declining costs which are benefiting all electric consumers under NH's current net metering system.
