In my role as a minister, I'm often asked by people in our community for food and energy assistance. I work with other area churches to help care for those who struggle to make ends meet. One notable local program, offered by Plymouth Area Renewable Energy Initiative, helps homeowners improve the energy efficiency of their residence and uses proceeds from a number of solar arrays to give them credit on their electric bills. The need for this kind of assistance far outstrips the current capacity.

I am writing in support of the settlement agreement for docket number 22-060. This is supported by a broad coalition of public utilities, private companies, and the Office of Consumer Advocate. Support for settlement agreement will help our efforts to meet the financial and energy needs of many in our community. I'm writing to ask that you support this settlement.
