I write in support of the proposed Docket 22-060 settlement, with the qualifications forward by CPCNH. We must move forward expeditiously on this, as on many other issues pertaining to the transition to clean & renewable energy sources.

If we had started working seriously on large-scale R&D 30-40 years ago, there might have been some justification for taking an extremely deliberate approach and micro-managing every detail. Unfortunately, we did not do so, and today the science is perfectly clear: There is a real time pressure to make substantive changes before the most problematic symptoms of the altered climate system set in. (In many parts of the world, they are already setting in.)

Let's not get hung up on navel-gazing here. NEM is a small step to incentivize increased adoption of solar by households and businesses. We need to do this, and a lot more.
