Governor Sununu,

I recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission is about to release an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. I understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by the three investor-owned electric utilities, Clean Energy NH, Conservation Law Foundation (CLF), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the NH Hydro Association.

I urge the PUC to accept this Settlement Agreement.

Our church is looking into adding Solar Panels as part of its commitment to be good stewards of God's creation and to free up more church resources to feed those in need. Net metering is a key factor in our decision-making; we need it to support our several food programs.
