I recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission is about to release an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. I understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by the three investor-owned electric utilities, Clean Energy NH, Conservation Law Foundation (CLF), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the NH Hydro Association.

**I urge the PUC to accept this Settlement Agreement. I have solar panels on my home. Net Metering is only fair compensation for adding electrons to the grid. It enables state residents to reduce their carbon footprint while reducing their cost of electricity by generating some on their own. It helps avoid construction of costly generating facilities. Without it, almost nobody would erect solar panels in New Hampshire.**
