I recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission is about to release an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. I understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by the three investor-owned electric utilities, Clean Energy NH, Conservation Law Foundation (CLF), the Office of the Consumer Advocate (OCA), and the NH Hydro Association.

When I cross over one of bridges into Vermont I am so impressed by how much more abundant the roof top solar panels are in VT than in NH. I see no reason that NH should be encouraging **MORE** solar, not less.

I am copying the PUC Clerk on this email so that my concern and support for the Settlement Agreement will be entered into the docket.
