We recently learned that the NH Public Utilities Commission will soon issue an Order concerning PUC Docket DE 22-060 on Changes to the Current Net Metering Tariff Structure. We understand a Settlement Agreement has been filed by several parties in addition to other proposals offered by the Community Power Coalition and the NH Department of Energy.

We urge the PUC to accept this Settlement Agreement with the proposed modifications by the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire. We support enabling net metered customers to participate in their Community Power programs and request that the improvements to load settlement be implemented to enable this. We believe New Hampshire can be a leader in innovative local energy markets even as a modern grid is developed to serve all residents in a fashion that is both economically feasible and ecologically looking to the future.

We are copying the PUC Clerk on this email so that our concern and support for the Settlement Agreement will be entered into the docket as a public comment.
