Dear Chairman Goldner:

Pursuant to the Hearing Guidelines issued on September 20, 2022, in the above- captioned matter, Clean Energy NH ("CENH") submits this request that its witness, Mr. R. Thomas Beach, Principal with Crossborder Energy, be granted permission to appear remotely at the August 20, 2024, and August 22, 2024 hearings scheduled in this matter.

Mr. Beach is located in Berkeley, California and requiring him to travel to New Hampshire for the hearings would be unduly burdensome for both Mr. Beach and Clean Energy NH's limited budgetary resources. CENH further notes that Mr. Beach's testimony was critical to CENH's initial position in the docket, but his testimony at the hearing will be supportive rather than central to the Settlement Agreement filed on August 1, 2020.

Clean Energy NH, therefore, requests that Mr. Beach be allowed to appear remotely.
