<u>CPCNH response to Joint Party order of witness presentation for the August 20 and 22, 2024 hearings</u>

Dear Clerk,

At 4:17pm today, Attorney Jessica Chiavara of Eversource Energy filed a joint party proposal for order of witnesses for the hearings on behalf of all parties. Unfortunately, Attorney Chiavara misrepresented the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire (CPCNH) in her filing as CPCNH did not consent to this order of witness presentation. In fact, we shared our concerns with Attorney Chiavara and several of the other parties via email on August 9, 2024. In that email, we suggested that it would be more efficient for the rebuttal panel to be integrated into the settlement panel. If the Commission chooses to go along with the proposed order that Attorney Chiavara and the other parties suggested, and as also indicated in CPCNH's August 9 email, CPCNH would request an opportunity for sur-rebuttal and note that there is no petitioning party in this proceeding.
