**Re: Unitil Energy Systems, Inc., Docket No. DE 23-002 (Phase II)
Supplemental Testimony**

Dear Chairman Goldner:

On September 18, 2024, the Department of Energy, the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire, and Direct Energy Services, LLC, Direct Energy Business, LLC, Direct Energy Business Marketing, LLC, Reliant Energy Northeast LLC, and XOOM Energy New Hampshire, LLC (together the "Intervenors") filed written comments on Unitil Energy Systems Inc.'s ("Unitil" or the "Company") proposed revisions to the Competitive Electric Supplier Trading Partner Agreement ("TPA") and Terms and Conditions for Competitive Suppliers ("T&C") tariff to implement the Purchase of Receivables Program.

Pursuant to Puc 203.06(e), if issues arise in a proceeding which were not reasonably anticipated by the petitioner, the commission shall allow the petitioner to file supplemental direct testimony or comments on the new or unanticipated issues. Unitil has reviewed the comments and many of the issues raised by the Intervenors were not anticipated by the Company when it drafted the proposed revisions to its TPA and T&C tariff. Accordingly, the Company is filing the enclosed Supplemental Testimony, and the associated attachments, to present the Company's proposals to address the issues raised by the Intervenors. Notably, Unitil proposes to accept the majority of the revisions to the TPA and T&C tariff identified by the Intervenors. This should narrow the issues in dispute among the parties and, hopefully, make for a more administratively efficient hearing before the Commission.
