Re: Northern Utilities, Inc., New Hampshire Division - Docket DG 23-085, September 2024 Monthly Cost of Gas Report for 2024 Summer Season

Chair Goldner,

Pursuant to Commission Order No. 26,713 in Docket DG 23-085, enclosed is Northern Utilities Inc.'s ("Northern") current calculation of its projected over or undercollection of gas costs for the 2024 summer season.

Northern's current calculation of costs, which has been updated to reflect the Company's April 30, 2024 target balance and NYMEX futures prices as of September 23, 2024 produces an anticipated over-recovery of gas costs for the 2023-2024 summer period. As a result, Northern is lowering its summer period cost of gas ("COG") rates to reflect a decrease in the projected cost of gas of \$189,624 or 4.1%. Support for this decision is provided in the attached summary and tables. Accordingly, pursuant to its tariff, the Company has enclosed for filing the following Tariff Pages reflecting a decrease in its COG Rates:

Twentieth Revised Page 43, Thirty-second Revised Page 86, Thirty-first Revised Page 88.

These Tariff Pages are issued September 23, 2024 to be effective on October 1, 2024. Red-lined versions of these Tariff Pages are also enclosed. The impact of the October 1 change in COG rates on the typical residential heating customer for the 2024 summer season will be a decrease of \$2.15 or about 4% less than the October bill at the Company's current COG rate.
