Motion for Remote Participation

Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp., d/b/a Liberty, through counsel, respectfully moves the Commission pursuant to Puc 203.07 to allow for remote participation of Liberty's witnesses Green and Doll at the September 11, 2024, hearing in this docket.

Witnesses Christopher Green and Aaron Doll are based in Joplin, Missouri, and the Commission has previously granted requests for their remote participation in this and in prior default service dockets to save the costs of travel and of their time, which costs are ultimately borne by Liberty's customers. The Company again requests approval of Mr. Green's and Mr. Doll's remote participation for the same cost-saving reasons.

Should the Commission grant the OCA's or Liberty's pending requests to reschedule the September 11, 2024, hearing, Liberty respectfully asks that an order granting this motion apply to the rescheduled hearing date.

The Department of Energy assents to the relief sought. The Office of the Consumer Advocate did not indicate its position prior to this filing.

WHEREFORE, Liberty respectfully requests that the Commission:

- (1) Allow Mr. Green and Mr. Doll to participate remotely in the September 11, 2024, hearing; and
- (2) Order such further relief as may be just and equitable.
