Partially Assented-to Motion for Remote Participation

Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp., d/b/a Liberty, through counsel, respectfully moves the Commission pursuant to Puc 203.07 to allow for remote participation of Liberty's witnesses Doll, Garcia, and Green at the December 23, 2024, hearing in this docket.

Witnesses Christopher Green and Aaron Doll are based in Joplin, Missouri, and the Commission has previously granted requests for their remote participation in this and in prior default service dockets to save the costs of travel and of their time, which costs are ultimately borne by Liberty's customers. The Company again requests approval of Mr. Green's and Mr. Doll's remote participation for the same cost-saving reasons.

Witness Robert Garcia will also be out of state on December 23 to be with family for the holidays. Thus the Company requests approval of Mr. Garcia's remote participation.

The Department of Energy does not object to the relief sought. The Office of the Consumer Advocate "takes no position."

WHEREFORE, Liberty respectfully requests that the Commission:

- (1) Allow Messrs. Doll, Garcia, and Green to participate remotely in the December 23, 2024, hearing; and
- (2) Order such further relief as may be just and equitable.
