Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp., d/b/a Liberty, through counsel, respectfully moves the Commission pursuant to Puc 203.07 to allow for remote participation of Liberty's witnesses Green and Garcia at the June 25, 2024, hearing in this docket.
