The Commission requests that the currently existing parties respond to the following by August 2, 2024 for each Petition:

1. Whether or not the Petition to Intervene could be limited in scope that would still enable the intervenors to participate in the proceeding to protect each the intervenor's rights, duties, privileges, immunities or other substantial interests but still allows the proceeding to proceed in an orderly manner?

- 2. What limitations, if any, should be placed on each Petition to Intervene knowing that RSA 541-A:32 allows for the following:
 - a. Limitation of the intervenor's participation to designated issues in which the intervenor has a particular interest demonstrated by the petition.
 - b. Limitation of the intervenor's use of cross-examination and other procedures so as to promote the orderly and prompt conduct of the proceedings.
 - c. Requiring 2 or more intervenors to combine their presentations of evidence and argument, cross-examination, and other participation in the proceedings.
