RE: Puc 2204.04 Commencement of Service Notice | City of Berlin, Town of Bristol

Pursuant to Puc 2204.04 I am writing to provide official Notification of Community Power Aggregation Commencement of Service not sooner than 90 days hence for the following municipalities for which the Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire serves as agent for purposes of implementing and operating their CPA programs:

City of Berlin	DE 24-067	Eversource
Town of Bristol	DE 24-072	Eversource

These Community Power Aggregations (CPAs) will be launched primarily on an opt-out alternative default service provider basis for customers served by Eversource.

Some groups of customers in the CPAs may be offered service only on an opt-in basis, particularly those that cannot be properly served by CPAs until certain data sharing and Puc 2200 rule compliance issues are resolved, including net energy metered customers.
