Low Income Electric Assistance Program, 2024 - 2025 EAP Budgets

Dear Chairman Goldner,

On July 31, 2024, Unitil Energy Systems, Inc. (the "Company") filed its Electric Assistance Program ("EAP") budget for the program year, October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025. By this letter, the Company clarifies that the EAP budget filed on July 31st does not reflect any administrative cost impacts associated with the Commission's recent Order No. 27,031 (July 9, 2024) issued in Docket No. DE 22-043. As noted in the July 31, 2024 letter filed by the Community Action Agencies ("CAPs") in this docket, the CAPs are reviewing Order No. 27,031 and anticipate that additional costs will need to be incorporated into their budgets. The Company will file a supplement budget at such time as the CAPs provide an estimate of any additional costs related to compliance with Order No. 27,031.
