Dear Chairman Goldner:

On August 8, 2024, the Commission issued a Commencement of Adjudicative Proceeding and Notice of Prehearing Conference and Hearing Order in the above-captioned docket. The Order set a hearing date of September 13, 2024, and requested that the New Hampshire Department of Energy ("DOE" or "Department") file its position regarding Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource's ("Eversource" or "Company") petition, including the reasons for this position, on or before August 30, 2024.

The Department has consulted with Eversource and the Office of the Consumer Advocate ("OCA") (together, "the Parties") regarding a proposed procedural schedule that allows the Department, as well as the OCA or any intervenor(s) if desired, to submit data requests to the Company and hold a technical session prior to submission of the Department's position statement.
