Complaint Against Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy

Procedural Order Re: Closure of Docket Proceeding Without Prejudice; Availability of Record in re: NHDOE Docket No. CPT 2023-002

The Commission, pursuant to a procedural order issued on April 24, 2024, scheduled a status conference for the above-captioned matter on May 8, 2024, and invited the parties to this case to file written updates with the Commission regarding the complaint by Community Power Coalition of New Hampshire (CPCNH) against Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource). Both CPCNH and Eversource filed such written updates with the Commission on May 1, 2024, and appeared at the May 8, 2024 status conference, at which representatives of the Office of the Consumer Advocate and the New Hampshire Department of Energy (DOE) also appeared.

In light of the statements made by the parties, *see* Transcript of May 8, 2024 Status Conference, *passim*, and the May 1 written updates by CPCNH and Eversource, the Commission makes the following rulings. Due to the ongoing complaint proceeding at the DOE (in DOE Docket No. CPT 2023-002) regarding the matters at issue involving CPCNH and Eversource, the Commission hereby CLOSES this instant complaint proceeding in Docket No. DE 23-062 WITHOUT PREJUDICE. Whereas N.H. Supreme Court Rule 14 (relating to Transmittal of the Record) does not apply to the Commission, in regard to a transfer of the evidentiary record, RSA 365:9, the Commission does invite the DOE and the parties to DOE Docket No. CPT 2023-002 to make use of the evidentiary record developed in this instant proceeding as appropriate, and give it the weight that it is due. If, upon

conclusion of the DOE proceeding in Docket No. CPT 2023-002, CPCNH is unsatisfied with the disposition of the Complaint by the DOE, CPCNH may petition the Commission to resolve the matter through an adjudicative proceeding on a *de novo* review basis. RSA 53-E:7, X.
